

Building Employability Skills: A SkillEd Initiative

The ‘Heartful Allies’ conducted a series of five workshops on *Graduate Employability Skills Training* as part of SkillEd. The sessions were delivered to undergraduate CSE students from a private university in Dhaka, Bangladesh. They took place from October 21, 2025 to December 30, 2025, and were held in both offline and online modes. The program was led by a trainer with a background in language education and skilling, along with co-trainers and resource speakers from language education, psychology, and Human Resource Management (HRM).

Each session covered a major skill: effective communication, teamwork and social interaction, emotional awareness, adaptability in different situations, and basic leadership skills. A total of 40 students attended the workshops, and those who completed all sessions were awarded certificates.
